The B.S.E. in Middle School Education is an on – campus program that consists of 120 credit hours and prepares candidates to work as middle school teachers in their selected content areas of language arts, mathematics, science (STEM), and social studies. SAU also offers degrees in math, English, social studies, and foreign language for those seeking secondary licensure. The middle school and secondary education tracks allow candidates to focus on specific content areas of most significant interest.

Program Notes:

- **SAU allows completion of MATH 1153 (Non-Math/Science focus area) or MATH 1053 (with Math/Science focus area)**
- **A minimum cumulative 2.7 GPA on transfer coursework for conditional admission. 3.0 for unconditional admission.**
- **Basic Skills competencies (for example: coursework, GPA, and/or testing Accuplacer Next Generation, CORE, ACT, or SAT) are required for unconditional admission. Conditional admission options are provided if not all requirements are met.**

No Certificate of Proficiency degree is eligible for Federal Financial Aid. Federal Financial Aid pays for courses of students pursuing Technical Certificate and/or higher degree.

Completing the CP/TC Teacher Assistant prepares students for the ParaPro Assessment. This is a general aptitude test required for paraprofessional certification. Testing scores are required for paraprofessional application at each school district within Arkansas.

This assessment measures foundational knowledge in the areas of Math, Writing, and Reading. The Praxis Study Companion for the ParaPro Assessment can be found here: <https://www.ets.org/s/parapro/pdf/1755.pdf>

Students interested in completing the ParaPro test should contact Callie Fore at the Southwest Arkansas Education Cooperative (SWAEC): 870-777-3076 ext 138; callie.fore@swaec.org. There is a \$75 test registration fee. Testing will need to be scheduled a week in advance. Test completion time is recommended for 2 ½ hours.
